Dear Parents & Carers,

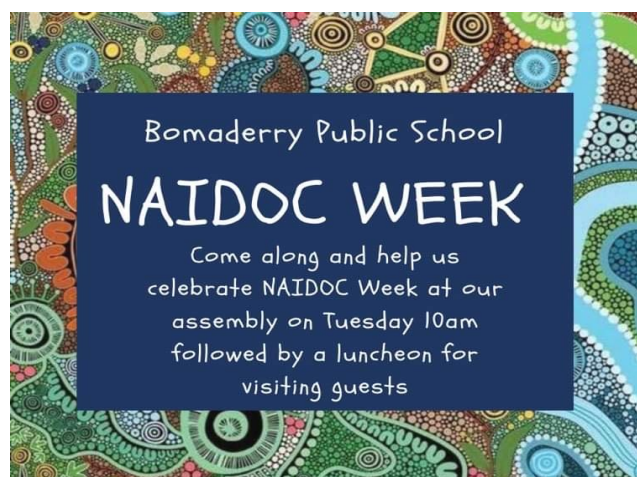

NAIDOC Week Celebrations at BPS This Week

NAIDOC Week celebrations are held across Australia each July to celebrate the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. The week is celebrated not only in Indigenous communities, but by Australians from all walks of life. NAIDOC will be celebrated across Australia from 4th-11th July. Because these dates are during the school holidays, our **BPS celebrations will be THIS WEEK, June 21st-25th.**



This year's NAIDOC theme is 'Heal Country, Heal Our Nation'; Country is inherent to our Aboriginal Australians' identity. It sustains lives in every aspect — spiritually, physically, emotionally, socially, and culturally. It is more than a place.

When Aboriginal people talk about Country it is spoken of like a person. Country is family, kin, law, lore, ceremony, traditions, and language. For Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples, it has been this way since the dawn of time.

The right to protect Country and culture is fundamental. Destruction and desecration of sacred lands or ancient sites — some of the oldest human occupation sites on the planet — is an enormous loss for both our nation and the world.

Healing Country is more than changing a word in our national anthem — it is about successfully empowering and celebrating Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, nations, and heritage. We are all looking for significant and lasting change.

BPS NAIDOC Timetable of Events:

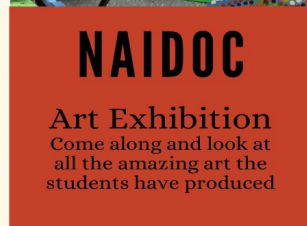
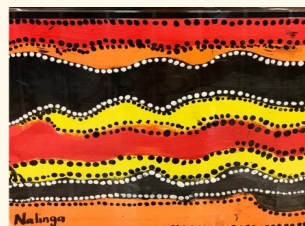
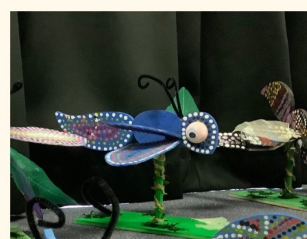

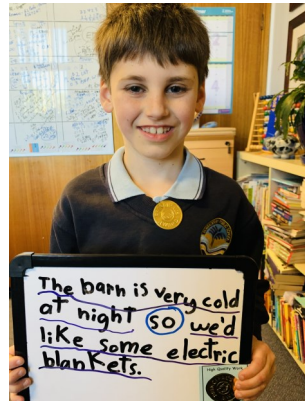


Quality Work at BPS

Sophie in **6T** achieved a spelling and a numeracy goal. **Chloe** achieved her goal of improving as an author, and also a numeracy goal.

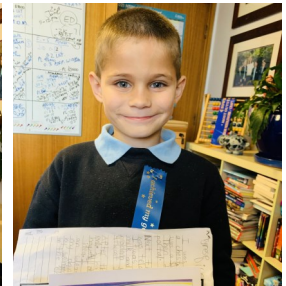
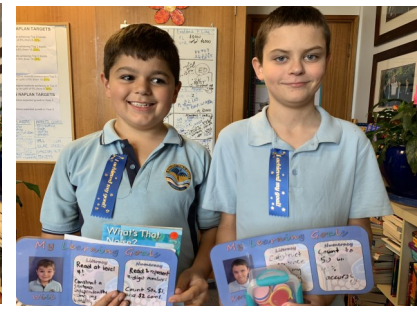
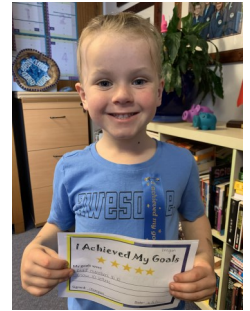
Tyrese in **3/4B** can use a variety of connectives in his writing to help it flow.

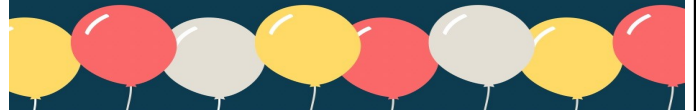
